THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) is made on this 19th Day of May 2017. Information Technology Sector has significant presence in teaching learning process. The main aim of the institution is to provide best infrastructure and opportunities to the learners and enable them to apply their knowledge to the challenging problems, including making at least one person in a family e- Literate, acting through the Information Technology Cell of the VES's Sarvajanik Arts and Commerce College, Visarwadi, Tal. Navapur, District-Nandurbar, Maharashtra acting through Dr. Asok Tongal Patil, Principal, VES's Sarvajanik Arts and Commerce College, Visarwadi. (hereinafter referred to as Institution which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns)

And

Nandurbar (M.S.) acting through Shri Pankaj Jagannath Pawar, owner (hereinafter referred to as DC which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the second part
- ii. Pragati Computer, having its registered computer center, at Bandharpada, Tal. Navapur, Distt. Nandurbar (M.S.) acting through Shri Shankar Jalamsing Gavit, owner (hereinafter referred to as PC which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the second part

VES's Sarvajani Arts & Commerce College, Visarwadi in partnership with DC and PC may hereinafter collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party" :

WHEREAS

1. VES's Sarvajani Arts and Commerce College, Visarwadi is seeking DC and PC to partners in the innovative and pioneering initiative in Information Technology Sector Skill Development that will attract the best students from this tribal region, providing them best infrastructure and opportunities to apply their knowledge to the challenging problems and works. The capabilities and expertise available with DC and PC in the area of Information Technology shall be synergised with the efforts of the Institution to provide better employment opportunities to the downtrodden youth. The Institution is also aiming towards capacity building of masses, in general through IT Literacy programmes for better proliferation of e-Governance services. The Institution recognizes that the courses like MSCIT and CCC are designed to equip a person to effectively use a computer for their day-to-day needs, and the Institution recommends that these programmes be accepted as an compulsory part of higher education during B.A. degree. The objectives inter-alia includes the followings.
 - a. To impart basic computer knowledge through private computer centres & Academia experts in close interaction to produce readily employable graduates.
 - b. To conduct recognized IT literacy training and certification courses Like Maharashtra State Certificate in Information Technology (MS-CIT) and Course on Computer Concept (CCC).
 - c. To provide a conducive e-learning environment through value addition e-programs.
 - c. To empower students living in remote tribal areas through mass IT literacy and appropriate skills so as to bridge the urban rural divide.
 - e. To conduct Continuing Education and Skill Development Training Programme.
 - f. To facilitate e-Governance initiatives like online scholarship, competitive exam, railway booking, e shopping, employment etc.

2. Computer Centers :

- a. Digilab Computer (DC) is 100% owned organisaion of Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Limited (MKCL), recognized by Govt. of Maharashtra.
- b. MSCIT & CCC certification programs have been duly recognized by Govt. of Maharashtra and made mandatory for employment as well as in-service promotions.
- c. Online examinations are conducted by DC and PC AT regular intervals and certifications are awarded by DC and PC to successful candidates.
- d. DC and PC both are recognised centers of the Govt.
- e. DC and PC are well enriched with latest IT infrastructure and material.
- f. Over the last decade, DC and PC has acquired very good expertise in Capacity Building in IT-Sector and e-Governance.

3. VES's Sarvajanik Arts & Commerce College, Visarwadi in partnership with DC and PC agree to enter into this MOU for the purpose mentioned here under.

NOW, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual covenants contained herein, constituting good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties mutually agree hereto as follows:


1. VES's Sarvajanik Arts & Commerce College, Visarwadi will provide the basic knowledge of computer to its students through the help of private computer centers in the area of IT.
- 2) Students of the Institution will be weighted first by DC and PC during admitting the students into the MS-CIT and CCC programmes.
- 3) VES's Sarvajanik Arts & Commerce College, Visarwadi and DC and PC shall be jointly responsible for certification of student trainees.
4. DC and PC will be responsible for following as a training partner :
 - a. Conduction of training
 - b. Conduction of theory / practical assessment as per standards
 - c. Evaluation & Certification.
5. DC and PC will ensure quality training by employing qualified and eligible trainers.
6. The Govt. rules will be followed in case of Fee and scholarship.
7. For effective implementation & monitoring of the scheme as envisaged in the MOU, there will be one Nodal Officer on behalf of DC, PC and one Nodal Office on behalf of Institution.
8. This MoU is a document of good faith and could be followed by and Agreement, if required.
9. This MoU will be effective up to 15 years beyond the date of signing this agreement, that is, up to 19 May, 2031. Implementation of the MoU would be monitored on annual basis.
10. Any dispute between the parties shall always be resolved by mutual consultation without any resort to arbitration or other form of legal remedy including resort to court of law.

11. Any notice/ communications required to be given by the parties shall be addressed to the parties at the address specified at the first page of this Mou.


