

National Service Scheme Annual Report

Academic year 2020-21

1. International Yoga Day: -

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June 2020 by the NSS Department. The online program was organized on the theme 'Yoga and Stress Management'. Speaker was Prof. Vilas Chavan. He gave guidance on the importance of yoga in this Covid-19 situation as there was an atmosphere of increased mental stress and tension among the citizens during the period of Covid-19 and also gave information on how to include yoga in the daily life of the youth for managing their stress. During the Presidential Concluding Remarks Dr. Adasule highlighted, how a person can lead a healthy and wholesome life through yoga to the participating students and teachers. 38 professors and students were attended.

2. Celebrate Social Justice Day: -

June 21, 2020 Shahu Maharaj's birthday was celebrated as Social Justice Day. The chief guests were Dr. Gopal Nimbalkar (Asst. Prof., Dr. B. A. College of Social Work, Morane, Dhule) and Prof. Naresh Patil (Asst. Prof., Kumbhalkar College of Social Work, Wardha).

Dr. Gopal Nimbalkar talk on Social Justice Day is celebrated for the contribution of Rajshri Shahu Maharaj in introducing the concept of social justice. Rajshri Shahu Maharaj did the work of giving complete justice. Throughout his life he worked as a king to solve various social problems. Rajshri Shahu Maharaj's birthday was celebrated on 26th June as Social Justice Day by the Government of Maharashtra considering the total contribution of his work as a social reformer and his work as a Maharashtra and the contribution of his work. This day is celebrated all over Maharashtra in government departments, colleges, school level and development institutions. If we look at the childhood of Rajshri Shahu Maharaj, then in the twentieth year, Shahu Maharaj was crowned and handed over the kingdom. He toured the entire state and studied the state situation, new types of social problems in the society and all that.

Prof. Naresh Patil was explaining the life and work of Rajshri Shahu Maharaj to the students, many kings who have become kings in the country have completed their careers. They are always

remembered in different ways and in different meanings. Working to create historical context, this king established social justice in the society with a broad vision. He had underlined the importance of his work. He spoke about how Rajshri Shahu Maharaj gave importance to reservation in his life, and also introduced the life of Shahu Maharaj to the students through many examples of social work done by Shahu Maharaj. 42 students, teachers and non-teaching staff of the college were present.

3. Plantation Program: -

According to a circular received by the NSS department of KBC NMU, Jalgaon on July 8, 2020, volunteers from each NSS unit were encouraged to plant sapling. 73 volunteers from our college planted trees in their homes, streets, neighborhoods, villages and their own farms and participated in these programs.

4. International Youth Day: -

On the occasion of International Youth Day, an online program was organized on 12 August 2020 on the theme "Role of Youth: Past, Present & Future". The chief guest was Dr. Bharat Khandagale (Asst. Prof., Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru College of Social Work, Amalner) and Chairperson was Prinipal Dr. Jalindar Adsule.

Dr. Khandagale gave valuable guidance on the theme. It discusses the current number of youth in India, their issues and the role of youth in nation building. First of all, he described the participation of the youth in the struggle for independence and the performance of the youth in the NSS during the present Covid-19 period. It also sheds light on various issues facing the youth. He also gave guidance on various schemes and campaigns of the government for the youth. At last he given the clarifications of the students questions.

Dr. Jalindar Adsule given the concluding remarks. He told youth need to nurture the latent qualities. He appealed to take care of his younger siblings and all the members of the family with him in the best possible situation.

5. Participation in (Gandagimukt Bharat Abhiyan) Dirt Free India Campaign through Tree Planting: -

According to a circular received by the NSS department of KBC NMU, Jalgaon on 12 August 2020, volunteers from each NSS unit were challenged to participate in the Dirt Free India Campaign



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through tree planting (Sampling). 25 volunteers participated in these events and planted trees in their homes, streets, neighborhoods, villages and on their own farms.

6. National Service Scheme Establishment Day: -

September 24, 2020 is celebrated as the foundation day of the National Service Scheme though online mode. The Speaker was Prof. Preeti Vahane. She gave in-depth guidance to the students. During her guidance to the students about the beginning of NSS, expectations from NSS volunteers, duties and responsibilities of volunteers towards the society and also explained to the students about the Motto of NSS, the symbol of NSS. How a NSS volunteer should be different from other students should create an identity between you and the NSS. 74 volunteers participated in the program.

7. Mahatma Gandhi Birth Anniversary: -

An online lecture on "Relevance of Gandhian Thoughts and Allegations Against Them" was organized online on 03 October 2020 on the occasion of Mahatma Gandhi Birth Anniversary. The Chief Guest was Honb. Ramesh Dane (Journalist, Dhule) and Chairperson was Hon. Dr. Jalindar Adsule Sir.


